### **FDOT to Host a Virtual Public Meeting for Roadway Improvement Project on State Road (SR) 915/NE 6 Avenue July 22, 2020**

**Miami, Fla.** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a Virtual Public Meeting for a roadway improvement project along SR 915/NE 6 Avenue from NE 113 Street to NE 121 Street from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m.

The proposed improvements include: adding new sidewalk on the eastside and westside along NE 6 Avenue; constructing a new drainage system; installing a new lighting system; upgrading signage and speed feedback signs; relocating or removing landscape within FDOT Right-of-Way (ROW) to make way for new sidewalk; widening the roadway to accommodate crosswalks; constructing crosswalks, curb ramps and pedestrian refuge islands at NE 113 Street; relocating roadside signs to make way for the new sidewalk and reconstructing non-decorative driveways within FDOT ROW. Construction is expected to begin in November 2021 and last about 10 months. The estimated construction cost for this project is \$2.5 million.
