FDOT to Host State Road (SR) 948/NW 36 Street Multimodal Planning Study Virtual Workshop *September 30, 2020*

Miami, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a Virtual Corridor Workshop to discuss a Multimodal Corridor Study for State Road (SR) 948/NW 36 Street from SR 826/Palmetto Expressway to SR 5/US 1/Biscayne Boulevard. The workshop will take place from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Wednesday, September 30, 2020 via GoToWebinar.

This Planning Study will evaluate the existing transportation conditions along the corridor and identify locations of recurring congestions, operational deficiencies, safety issues and multimodal needs.
