FDOT to Host a Virtual Public Meeting for a Roadway Improvement Project along State Road (SR) 9/NW 27 Avenue

September 15, 2020

Miami, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a Virtual Public Meeting for a roadway improvement project along SR 9/NW 27 Avenue from NW 39 Street to SR 934/NW 79 Street from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Tuesday, September 15, 2020 via GoToWebinar.

The proposed improvements include: repaving and restriping the roadway; removing abandoned driveways; upgrading drainage inlets in conflict with new pedestrian ramps; widening along the eastern leg of NW 41 Street to provide travel lane width; upgrading pedestrian curb ramps, signage and pavement markings; reconstructing and enhancing sidewalks along the roadway and upgrading guardrail and street signs. Construction is expected to begin in October 2021 and last about one year. The estimated construction cost for this project is \$6 million.
