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FDOT to Host a Virtual Public Kick-off Meeting for the Atlantic Isles Lagoon Bridge PD&E Study
October 27, 2020

MIAMI, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Six, will host a Virtual Public Kick-off Meeting to discuss the Atlantic Isles Lagoon Bridge Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study. This project extends from Atlantic Isles west of State Road (SR) A1A to Atlantic Avenue. The Virtual Public Kick-off Meeting will be held on Tuesday, October 27, 2020, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. via GoToWebinar.

The proposed PD&E Study will fully evaluate the impacts of potential alternatives to improve the existing bridge structure, so that it is safe and functional for the traveling public.
