Florida Department of Transportation to Host a Public Meeting

*Golden Glades Multimodal Transportation Facility and Truck Travel Center PD&E
Reevaluation Study*

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six has scheduled a public meeting regarding the Golden Glades Multimodal Transportation Facility and Truck Travel Center Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Reevaluation Study in Miami-Dade County, Florida. The meeting will be held on **Thursday, September 22, 2016 at the Evangel Church International at 590 NW 159 Street, Miami, FL. The meeting will be an open house from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m.** Graphic displays will be shown during the meeting, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project.

This meeting is being held to allow interested persons an opportunity to express their views concerning the location; conceptual design; and social economic, and environmental effects of the proposed improvements to the Golden Glades Multimodal Transportation Facility and Truck Travel Center PD&E Reevaluation. The project is being developed to determine the most efficient and environmentally friendly design concept to enhance the transit functions of the existing park and ride facilities. The project will address the existing deficiencies in multimodal connectivity, transfer efficiency, accessibility, comfort and convenience, safety and security, capacity, and commercial truck parking needs in Miami-Dade County.
