Four Southbound Lanes on State Road (SR) 826/Palmetto Expressway Closed May 6

Between SW 24 Street/Coral Way and SR 874/Don Shula Expressway

Miami, Fla. – On Wednesday, May 6, 2020, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will close four southbound lanes on SR 826/Palmetto Expressway between SW 24 Street/Coral Way and the southbound SR 874/Don Shula Expressway entrance ramp from 8:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. as part of a Districtwide Signage and Pavement Marking Pushbutton contract.

Two southbound lanes will remain open. Northbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway will not be affected.

Drivers should anticipate delays traveling through this area and seek alternate routes if possible. Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
