Full Closure of State Road (SR) 836

Miami — On **Monday, February 6** all eastbound and westbound lanes on SR 836 will close from NW 57 Avenue to NW 72 Avenue between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5 a.m. to allow the contractor to install an overhead message sign structure. The NW 57 Avenue entrance ramp to westbound SR 836 and the 72 Avenue ramp to eastbound SR 836 will also be closed during this time period.

On **Wednesday, February 8** all westbound lanes on SR 836 will be closed from NW 57 Avenue to NW 72 Avenue between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m. to fasten the electronic message board to the sign structure. The NW 57 Avenue ramp to westbound SR 836 will also be closed during this time period.

Drivers on westbound SR 836 can:

- Exit at NW 57 Avenue, go south
- Head west on NW 7 Street
- North on NW 72 Avenue
- Connect with the westbound SR 836 entrance ramp

Drivers on eastbound SR 836 can:

- Exit at NW 72 Avenue, go south
- Head east on NW 7 Street
- North on NW 57 Avenue
- Connect with the eastbound SR 836 entrance ramp

Drivers on NW 57 Avenue heading west on SR 836 can:

- Continue to Perimeter Road, go west
- Turn south on NW 72 Avenue
- Connect with the westbound SR 836 entrance ramp

Drivers on NW 72 Avenue heading east on SR 836 can:

- Go south on NW 72 Avenue
- Head east on NW 7 Street
- North on NW 57 Avenue
- Connect with the eastbound SR 836 entrance ramp

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.
