Miami Gardens Drive Entrance Ramp to Northbound I-95 Closed at Night for Landscaping Work

Beginning Thursday, November 3

Miami, FL – Beginning Thursday, November 3, the contractor for the State Road (SR) 9A/I-95 from NW 170 Street to Snake Creek Canal project will close the Miami Gardens Drive entrance ramp to northbound I-95 in order to install landscaping. The entrance ramp will be closed beginning at 10 p.m. through 5:30 a.m. on Friday, November 4.

A detour will be established for drivers traveling east and west on Miami Gardens Drive in this area.

Drivers traveling east on Miami Gardens Drive who wish to continue to I-95 northbound will have to:

- Turn north on NE 18 Avenue
- Turn east on NE 199 Street
- Turn north on Highland Lakes Boulevard
- Turn west on Ives Dairy Road
- Turn north on the I-95 northbound ramp

Drivers traveling west on Miami Gardens Drive who wish to continue to I-95 northbound will have to:

- Turn north on US 441/NW 2 Avenue
- Turn east on NW 199 Street/Ives Dairy Road
- Turn north on the I-95 northbound ramp
