Lane Closure for Landscaping Work Along Northbound I-95 at Miami Gardens Drive Ramp

Beginning Saturday, October 1

Miami, FL – Beginning Saturday, October 1, the contractor for the SR 9A/I-95 from NW 170 Street to Snake Creek Canal project will close a lane along northbound I-95 at the Miami Gardens Drive entrance ramp in order to install landscaping. The outside lane will be closed Saturday mornings beginning at 5 a.m. through 11 a.m. This work is scheduled during daytime hours only through Saturday, October 22. At least one lane will remain open at all times.
