Missouri – Little Duck Key Bridge Single Lane Shift and Closure to Occur on August 9 *Along State Road (SR) 5/US 1*

Miami, Fla. – On Sunday, August 9, there will be a nighttime traffic shift and lane closure at the Missouri – Little Duck Key Bridge located along SR 5/US 1/Overseas Highway, between Mile Marker (MM) 39.524 and MM 39.704, while workers install concrete barrier walls on the bridge. The work will be completed between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m.

To perform this work safely, a travel lane will be closed and traffic along the bridge will be shifted around the work zone, while being maintained by flagmen. Drivers will be required to proceed at a reduced rate of speed through the construction zone.

This schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.
