### Nighttime Lane Closures on Missouri – Little Duck Key Bridge, September 22 and 23 *State Road (SR) 5/US 1/Overseas Highway*

**Miami, Fla.** – A single lane closure will occur along SR 5/US 1, between MM 39.524 and MM 39.704, tonight, September 22 and tomorrow night, September 23, while the contractor completes final roadway work.

**The work will be completed nightly between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m.** To perform this work safely, traffic along the bridge will be maintained by flagmen, with one lane open to traffic at all times. Drivers will be required to proceed at a reduced rate of speed through the construction zone.

**This schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.**
