## **Overnight Lane Closures for Overhead Sign Work Along Northbound I-95 Just North of NW 8 Street**

*Friday, November 4 and Saturday, November 5, 10 p.m. to 9 a.m.*

**Miami, FL** – Up to four northbound lanes including the express lanes along I-95 just north of NW 8 Street in Miami-Dade County will be closed on Friday, November 4 and Saturday, November 5 from 10 p.m. to 9 a.m. **At least one lane will remain open at all times but motorists are encouraged to seek alternate routes.** Electronic message signs will advise drivers in advance.

This work is part of the overhead toll dynamic message signs (TDMS) replacement project in Miami-Dade County.

**Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.**
