Overnight Lane Closures for Overhead Sign Work Along Northbound I-95 at NW 17 Street

Friday, September 23 and Saturday, September 24, 10 p.m. to 9 a.m.

Miami, FL – Up to three northbound lanes along I-95 from NW 14 Street to NW 17 Street in Miami-Dade County will be closed on Friday, September 23 and Saturday, September 24 from 10 p.m. to 9 a.m. **At least one lane will remain open at all times but motorists are encouraged to seek alternate routes.** Electronic message signs will advise drivers in advance.

This work is part of the overhead toll dynamic message signs (TDMS) replacement project in Miami-Dade County.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
