Overnight Lane Closures for Overhead Sign Work Along Northbound I-95 at NW 17 Street

Friday, September 23 and Saturday, September 24, 10 p.m. to 9 a.m.

Miami, FL – Up to three northbound lanes along I-95 from NW 14 Street to NW 17 Street in Miami-Dade County will be closed on Friday, September 23 and Saturday, September 24 from 10 p.m. to 9 a.m. At least one lane will remain open at all times but motorists are encouraged to seek alternate routes. Electronic message signs will advise drivers in advance.

This work is part of the overhead toll dynamic message signs (TDMS) replacement project in Miami-Dade County.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
