## NW 37 Avenue Rail Crossing Closure begins Friday, December 17

**MIAMI, Fla.** – The South Florida Regional Transportation Authority (SFRTA), in coordination with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), will close NW 37 Avenue from NW 59 Street to NW 60 Street in Miami-Dade County from 4 a.m., Friday, December 17 through 4 a.m., Thursday, December 23, 2021, weather permitting. This detour is being established to allow workers to reconstruct the railroad crossing.

During this closure, all traffic will be detoured away from the crossing and directed to follow signs to alternate local streets. Traffic will be detoured as follows:

#### Westbound Detour:

- Turn left on NW 60 Street
- Turn right on NW 35 Avenue
- Turn right on NW 59 Street to get back to NW 37 Avenue

#### Eastbound Detour:

- Turn right on NW 59 Street
- Turn left on NW 35 Avenue
- Turn left on NW 60 Street to get back to NW 37 Avenue
