### **Traffic Advisory: FDOT Implements Rail Crossing Safety Measures in Miami-Dade County**

**MIAMI, Fla.** – As part of the Florida Department of Transportation’s (FDOT) [Operation STRIDE](#) initiative, FDOT is implementing rail crossing safety measures on state roadways with the goal of minimizing crashes at state road rail crossings. The work includes installation of Rail Dynamic Envelopes, which are pavement markings at rail crossings designed to keep motorists out of the danger area around railroad crossings identifying where vehicles should not stop.

Beginning Sunday, August 16, 2020, work will begin on State Road (SR) 5/US-1, SR 916/NE 135 Street and SR 922/NE 125 Street.

Motorists should expect possible lane closures near rail crossings as the work continues and reduce speeds in and near constructions zones. Please follow detour signs for alternative routes.
