FDOT to Host a Public Hearing for a Safety and Drainage Project

State Road (SR) 985/SW 107 Avenue at SR 94/SW 88 Street/Kendall Drive

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation District Six (FDOT) will host a public hearing for a safety enhancement and drainage improvement project at SR 985/SW 107 Avenue at SR 94/SW 88 Street/Kendall Drive, in Miami-Dade County. Construction is expected to begin in January 2018 and last for about seven months. The estimated construction cost of the projects is \$1.9 million.

The public hearing will be held from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Tuesday, September 20 2016, at Riverside Baptist Church, Room Fellowship Hall (FH), 10775 SW 104 Street, Miami, FL 33176. The hearing will begin as an open house, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m., with a formal presentation starting at 6:30 p.m. Graphic displays will be shown during the hearing, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the projects.

The proposed work for these projects include:

Safety

- Installing an additional left turn lane along southbound SR 985/SW 107 Avenue, as well as extending the eastbound, westbound and northbound left turn lanes at the intersection
- Increasing pedestrian signal timing at the intersection
- Upgrading signalization in the intersection
- Updating roadway signage and pedestrian ramps to current standards
- Upgrading overhead signal heads in the eastbound and westbound directions
- Trimming existing landscape at the intersection
- Relocating the existing bus stop located south of the intersection on the eastside of the roadway
- Repaving and restriping the roadway

Drainage

- Upgrading drainage system along SR 985/SW 107 Avenue
