RESCHEDULED: Public Meeting for a Roadway Improvement Project

State Road (SR) 997/Krome Avenue from SW 312 Street/Campbell Drive to SW 296 Street

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six has **rescheduled** the public meeting for a roadway improvement project along SR 997/Krome Avenue from SW 312 Street/Campbell Drive to SW 296 Street, in Miami-Dade County. **The public meeting is rescheduled for Wednesday, November 16, 2016 from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m., at the William F. Dickinson Community Center, 1601 N. Krome Avenue, Homestead, FL, 33030.** Construction is expected to begin in September 2019 and last 33 months. The estimated construction cost of the project is \$3.5 million.

Graphic displays will be shown during the meeting and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project.

The proposed work for these project include:

- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Removing parking and bicycle lanes
- Widening the roadway from SW 300 Street (NW 19 Street) to SW 296 Street to continue through lane
- Improving drainage system
- Enhancing existing traffic and pedestrian signals to current standards
- Upgrading signage pavement markings
