## **Overnight Lane Closures for Overhead Sign Work Along Southbound I-95 Just North of NW 151 Street**

*Friday, October 21 and Saturday, October 22, 10 p.m. to 9 a.m.*

---

**Miami, FL** – Up to two southbound lanes along I-95 just north of NW 151 Street in Miami-Dade County will be closed on Friday, October 21 and Saturday, October 22 from 10 p.m. to 9 a.m. **At least one lane will remain open at all times but motorists are encouraged to seek alternate routes.** Electronic message signs will advise drivers in advance. While this work is being performed, the connector ramp from eastbound State Road (SR) 826/Palmetto Expressway and Florida's Turnpike to southbound I-95 will be closed and a detour will be in place.

**Eastbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway and Florida's Turnpike drivers who wish to access the connector ramp to southbound I-95 can:**

- Exit at SR 7/US 441/NW 7 Avenue
- Turn south onto SR 7/US 441/NW 7 Avenue
- Turn east onto NW 151 Street for southbound I-95

This work is part of the overhead toll dynamic message signs (TDMS) replacement project in Miami-Dade County. **Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.**
