Overnight Lane Closures for Overhead Sign Work Along Southbound I-95 Just South of NW 167 Street

Friday, October 14 and Saturday, October 15, 10 p.m. to 9 a.m.

Miami, FL – Up to two southbound lanes along I-95 just south of NW 167 Street in Miami-Dade County will be closed on Friday, October 14 and Saturday, October 15 from 10 p.m. to 9 a.m. **At least one lane will remain open at all times but motorists are encouraged to seek alternate routes.** Electronic message signs will advise drivers in advance. While this work is being performed, the southbound I-95 entrance ramps from southbound US 441/NW 2 Avenue and westbound NW 167 Street will be closed and the following detours will be in place.

Southbound drivers on US 441/NW 2 Avenue who wish to access the entrance ramp to southbound I-95 can:

- Continue south on US 441/NW 2 Avenue, which becomes US 441/NW 7 Avenue
- Turn east onto NW 151 Street for southbound I-95

Westbound drivers on NW 167 Street who wish to access the entrance ramp to southbound I-95 can:

- Continue west on NW 167 Street
- Take ramp to southbound US 441/NW 7 Avenue
- Turn east onto NW 151 Street for southbound I-95

This work is part of the overhead toll dynamic message signs (TDMS) replacement project in Miami-Dade County. **Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.**
