Lane Closures on State Road (SR) 7/US 441/NW 7 Avenue

Miami, Fla. – One southbound lane on SR 7/US 441/NW 7 Avenue will be continuously closed from NW 14 Street to NW 15 Street starting at 8 a.m. on Thursday, October 1 until 8 a.m. on Thursday, October 15. A second southbound lane will be closed on weekdays between the hours of 8 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. During the closure of the second lane, southbound drivers will be diverted to the median lane to continue south. The lane closures will allow the contractor to construct bridge foundations on the west side of the roadway.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions. The closures are part of the I-395/SR 836/I-95 Design-Build Project that will reconstruct the I-395 corridor from the SR 836/I-395/I-95 (Midtown) Interchange to the MacArthur Causeway Bridge, including the construction of a Signature Bridge over NE 2 Avenue and Biscayne Boulevard; double-deck SR 836 from west of NW 17 Avenue to the Midtown Interchange and the replacement of the concrete pavement on I-95 from NW 8 Street to NW 29 Street.
