Closure of all Southbound State Road (SR) 826 Travel Lanes at NW 25 Street

***Miami, FL* — All southbound travel lanes will be closed at NW 25 Street on Friday, September 16 (Saturday, September 17 is an alternate date) between the hours of 11 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.**

Southbound drivers on SR 826 can:

- Exit at NW 25 Street, east on NW 25 Street, south on NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road
- South on NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road to West Flagler Street
- West on West Flagler Street to access the SR 826 south ramp

Southbound drivers on SR 826 going to eastbound SR 836 can:

- Exit at NW 25 Street, east on NW 25 Street,
- South on NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road to access the SR 836 east ramp

Southbound drivers on SR 826 going to westbound SR 836 can:

- Exit at NW 25 Street, east on NW 25 Street, south on NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road
- West on NW 11 Street to access SR 836 west ramp
