Roadway Construction on State Road (SR) 925/NW 3 Court/NW 3 Avenue Begins June 1 *SR 925/NW 3 Court/NW 3 Avenue from NW 1 Street to NW 8 Street*

Miami, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will begin a roadway construction project the week of June 1, 2020. The project limits extend along SR 925/NW 3 Court/NW 3 Avenue from NW 1 Street to NW 8 Street and will cost an estimated \$5.1 million.

The work will last roughly 11 months and includes the following: reconstructing pedestrian curb ramps; enhancing sidewalks and guardrails; installing new drainage structures; improving vehicular and pedestrian traffic signals and signage; installing bicycle lane signage and pavement markings; repaving and restriping the roadway.

To build this project safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes and sidewalks and establish detours at times. Work will be done in stages to minimize construction-related impacts. Please use caution when traveling through construction zones.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
