### State Road (SR) 922/NE 125 Street Paving Begins June 23

*Intersection of NE 125 Street and NE 10 Avenue*

**MIAMI, Fla.** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will repave the intersection of SR 922/NE 125 Street and NE 10 Avenue tonight, June 23, and tomorrow, June 24, between 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Travel lanes will be closed, and flaggers will direct traffic through the work zone. Motorists should anticipate delays and be prepared to stop.
