FDOT to Host a Public Meeting for two Repaving and Intersection Improvement Projects

State Road (SR) 933/NW 12 Avenue from NW 20 Street and NW 29 Street

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a Public Meeting for two repaving and intersection improvement projects along SR 933/NW 12 Avenue from NW 20 Street to NW 29 Street, in Miami-Dade County. Construction is expected to begin in April 2022 and last about eight months. The estimated construction cost for this project is about \$2.1 million.

A Public Meeting will be held from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Thursday, August 15, 2019 at the Juan Pablo Duarte Park, 1776 NW 28 Street, Miami, FL 33142. Graphic displays will be shown during the meeting, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss these projects.

The proposed improvements include: repaving and restriping the roadway, upgrading pedestrian curb ramps, signing and pavement markings, improving pedestrian crosswalks and signals, widening the northeast corner of NW 20 Street to improve turning radius, installing flashing beacons between NW 24 Street and NW 25 Street and enhancing sidewalks.
