Snake Creek Bridge Intermittent Traffic Stoppages to Occur April 24 through 26

Along State Road (SR) 5/US 1/Overseas Highway

Miami, Fla. – Temporary nighttime closures will occur on Friday, April 24 through Sunday, April 26, on US 1 at the Snake Creek Bridge between 9 p.m. and 4 a.m., while the Contractor performs cleaning and painting of the structural steel components.

This work requires the drawbridge to be opened and closed briefly one or more times. Drivers will be required to wait on either side of the bridge until the bridge reopens. This work is being done as part of the ongoing bridge rehabilitation project.

This schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.
