### **Street Lighting Improvements Along State Road (SR) 9/NW/SW 27 Avenue Begin June 15** *From SW 27 Terrace to NW 46 Street*

**Miami, Fla.** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will begin a lighting improvement project the week of June 15, 2020 along SR 9/NW/SW 27 Avenue from SW 27 Terrace to NW 46 Street. This project will cost an estimated \$295,658.

The work will last roughly seven months and include the following: upgrading existing light poles at selected intersections; removing and/or replacing existing light poles at selected intersections; adding new light poles at selected intersections.

To build this project safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes and sidewalks, and establish detours at times. Work will be done in stages to minimize construction-related impacts. Please use caution when traveling through construction zones.

**Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.**
