**Various Bridges Throughout Miami-Dade County**  
*Project Final Accepted on July 26*

**Miami, Fla.** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) completed a bridge rehabilitation project on July 26, 2019 that includes various bridges throughout Miami-Dade County. The project started in February 2019 and featured approximately \$127,676 in bridge rehabilitation and improvements.

The following work was performed on the project: repairing the underside of the bridges. The bridge locations included Caribbean Boulevard over Bel Aire Canal (bridge number 874431), SW 127 Avenue over Black Creek Canal (bridge number 874338), SW 99 Avenue over Snapper Creek Canal (bridge number 874255), NW 95 Street over Little River Canal (bridge number 874122) and NW 22 Avenue over Little River Canal (bridge number 874334).

FDOT completed this project with the support of elected officials and the community. Oceaneer Consulting, Inc. was the contractor.
