Weekend Schedule for Continuous Lane Closures on Northbound I-95

Miami, Fla. – On Friday, May 8 and Saturday, May 9, up to three lanes on northbound I-95 will be closed from north of SR 836 to NW 29 Street between the hours of 8 p.m. and 10 a.m. At 10 p.m. all three northbound lanes from SR 836 to NW 19 Street will be closed and drivers will be diverted to the I-195 ramp (Exit 4A) just after SR 836 to continue northbound. At 10 a.m., two lanes will re-open and *one lane from north of NW 11 Street to approximately NW 20 Street, and two lanes from NW 20 Street to NW 29 Street will remain continuously closed for approximately three weeks.* Weeknight lane closures of the three northbound lanes will resume on Monday, May 11 between the hours of 8 p.m. and 6 a.m.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions. The closures are part of the I-395/SR 836/I-95 Design-Build Project that will reconstruct the I-395 corridor from the SR 836/I-395/I-95 (Midtown) Interchange to the MacArthur Causeway Bridge, including the construction of a Signature Bridge over NE 2 Avenue and Biscayne Boulevard; double-deck SR 836 from west of NW 17 Avenue to the Midtown Interchange and the replacement of the concrete pavement on I-95 from NW 8 Street to NW 29 Street.
