Temporary Northbound 95 Express Lanes Entrance Opened


Miami, *FL* – The entrance to the northbound 95 Express Lanes has been temporarily moved approximately one mile north to NW 42 Street. The entrance will remain in this location for about two years while workers build emergency stopping sites in the express lanes and replace the concrete pavement on northbound I-95.

This work is part of the I-95 Design/Build Project to construct five emergency stopping sites on I-95 from NW 62 Street to NW 131 Street, and replace the concrete pavement from NW 29 Street to NW 79 Street.
