State Road (SR) 997/Krome Avenue

From South of SW 136 Street to South of SR 94/SW 88 Street/Kendall Drive
Project Identification Number: 249614-7-52-01

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six is developing the design for a roadway project along SR 997/Krome Avenue, in Miami-Dade County.

PROJECT DETAILS

- Constructing a new roadway along SR 997/Krome Avenue from south of SW 136 Street to south of SR 94/SW 88 Street/Kendall Drive. The new roadway will be four lanes divided with paved shoulders on both sides and will be constructed using concrete pavement
- Constructing two new bridges (one for northbound and one for southbound traffic) across the Black Creek Canal
- Adding a shared-use path on the east side of the roadway for bicyclists and pedestrians
- Installing guardrail within the median
- Installing new drainage structures
- Installing new traffic signs
- Installing lighting
- Installing traffic signals at the intersections of SR 94/Krome Avenue and SW 136 Street

PROJECT DATES

Construction is expected to begin in August 2016 and last about 2.5 years.

ESTIMATED CONSTRUCTION COST *UPDATE*

\$44.4 million

POSSIBLE EFFECTS DURING CONSTRUCTION

Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects of construction on the community.

MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC

Travel lanes will be closed at times for safety reasons and lane closures will take place during non-peak hours. One lane in each direction will be maintained open at all times
