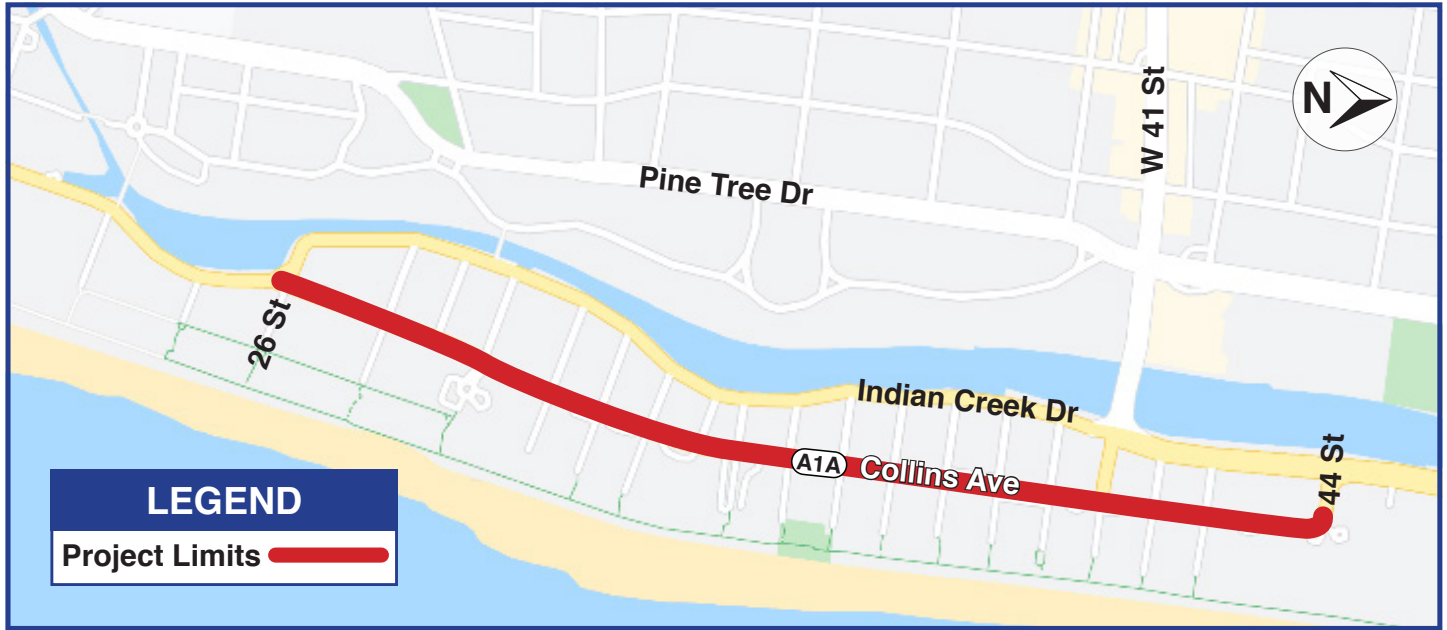

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is developing the design for a roadway improvement project SR A1A/Collins Avenue from 26 Street to 44 Street in Miami-Dade County.

### PROJECT DETAILS

- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Adjusting manholes
- Upgrading signing and pavement markings
- Reconstructing damaged sidewalks, ramps and curb and gutter
- Upgrading crosswalks
- Adding sharrows to the outside lane pavement markings
- Trimming trees and shrubs encroaching into the roadway/sidewalks
- Relocating some light poles
- Upgrading pedestrian signs and push-buttons
- Removing three parking spaces between 38 Street and 39 Street at the crosswalk location
- Improving drainage
- Adding signs before the
- 44 Street/Indian Creek Drive signal
- Widening the roadway just before the 44 Street signal to make way for two left turn lanes and two right turn lanes

### ESTIMATED PROJECT COST

\$3.1 million

### PROJECT DATES

Work is expected to begin in May 2023 and last about nine months. Please note that the construction start date and duration is subject to change.

### POSSIBLE EFFECTS DURING CONSTRUCTION

Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects of construction on the community. Vehicular and pedestrian traffic will be impacted.

### MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC

During construction, there will be temporary lane closures during non-peak hours and detours will have effects on traffic. There will be temporary impacts to the existing parallel parking. Pedestrian detours will be established with clear signage. Access to adjacent businesses and neighbourhoods will be maintained.
