


Project Location Map





What to Expect During Construction

Maintenance of Traffic (MOT):

Lane closures and ramp detours shall occur only on nonevent days/weekends during non-peak hours



Non-peak hours are:

- 9 PM to 5 AM Sunday through Friday morning
- 11 PM to 9 AM Friday through Sunday morning

- Phase 1:
 - Replacing damaged concrete pavement (Inside Lanes)

 - Improving signalization
