

- The purpose of the project is to enhance the roadway and safety
- This intersection had two fatal crashes with vehicles making a left turn in the southwest direction from SR 5/US 1 onto SW 137 Avenue

Project Scope

- Modifying access to Tropical Avenue to a right turn only and constructing a traffic separator
- Relocating the U-turn movement south of the intersection
- Extending the traffic separator to increase the left turn storage
- Adding a northbound left turn movement toward the westside




Project Scope

- Enhancing pedestrian ramps, signs and pavement markings
- Adding a new traffic signal
- Repaying and restriping the roadway
- Upgrading lighting
- Relocating landscape




SR 5/US 1 at SW 137 Avenue

Maintenance of Traffic (MOT):

- Lane closures shall occur only during non-peak hours
 or on non-event days/weekends
- At least one travel lane will remain open at all times

Non-peak hours are:

- 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Weekdays and Weekends
- 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Sunday through Thursday
- 11 p.m. to 7 a.m. Friday and Saturday





- Phase 1:
 - o Installing temporary and new pedestrian ramps
 - Maintaining traffic on existing lane configuration
- Phase 2:
 - Constructing median widening and roadway features
- Phase 3:
 - Repaving and restriping the pavement with temporary lane closures







Posted Speed:

 Existing speed limit of 45 Mile Per Hour (MPH) along SR 5/US 1 will remain



Dust:

• The contractor will be required to water and sweep in order to minimize construction-related dust



Noise:

• Some noise should be expected during allowable construction time
