State Road (SR) 860/Miami Gardens Drive/NW 183/186 Street From SR 93/I-75 to SR 823/NW 57 Avenue Project Identification Numbers: 438864-2/3/4-52-01

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is developing the design for a roadway project along SR 860/Miami Gardens Drive/NW 183-168 Street from SR 93/I-75 to SR 823/NW 57 Avenue, in Miami-Dade County.

#### **PROJECT DETAILS**

- Widening the roadway to accommodate one additional travel lane in each direction and a shareduse path on the north side of Miami Gardens Drive
- Closing the median openings at various locations
- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Modifications to drainage, manholes, and curb ramps
- Upgrading lighting, sidewalk, pedestrian signing and pavement markings
- Adding new vehicular and pedestrian signalization at the intersections of:
  - NW 87 Avenue; NW 82 Avenue; NW 75 Place;
    NW 73 Avenue; NW 68 Avenue, Bob-O-Link Drive;
    NW 67 Avenue; NW 62 Avenue and NW 57
    Avenue

# **ESTIMATED PROJECT COST AND DATES**

- SR 860/Miami Gardens Drive/NW 186 Street from SR 93/I-75 to NW 79 Place
  \$15 million (combined)
  Work is expected to begin in July 2025 and last about 20 months
- SR 860/Miami Gardens Drive/NW 183/186 Street from NW 79 Place to NW 57 Avenue \$32 million (combined)
   Work and construction lengths are to be determined.

Please note that the construction start date and duration is subject to change.

#### POSSIBLE EFFECTS DURING CONSTRUCTION

Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects of construction on the community. Vehicular and pedestrian traffic will be impacted.

### **MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC**

During construction, temporary lane closures during non-peak hours and detours may affect traffic. Pedestrian detours will be established with clear signage. Access to adjacent businesses and residences will be maintained.
