

SR 90/SW 8 Street/Tamiami Trail from Beacom Boulevard to SW 2 Avenue





### **Project Scope**

- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Improving drainage along SW 8 Street between SW 21 Avenue and east of SW 18 Avenue
- Replacing substandard curb ramps
- Updating traffic signals
- Updating pedestrian signalization and signage
- Providing a dedicated left turn lane on to SW 2 Avenue, which requires removing 11 parking spaces





### **Project Schedule and Cost**

Letting/Bidding Date	April 2024
Construction Estimated Start date	November 2024
Construction Estimated Duration	360 days
Construction Estimated End date	November 2025
Total Estimated Construction Cost	\$3.6 million



### SR 90/Tamiami Trail/SW 8 St and SW 21 Ave Drainage Improvement (System 1)






### SR 90/Tamiami Trail/SW 8 St and SW 20 Ave Drainage Improvement (System 2)














#### SR 90/Tamiami Trail/SW 8 St at SW 4 Ave

#### **Maintenance of Traffic (MOT):**

- Lane closures shall occur only during non-peak hours or on non-event days/nights/weekends
- The proposed drainage system will be constructed one block at a time, drop off conditions will be covered with steel plates
- Two travel lanes will remain open, except during the drainage work (per block segments)



- 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Monday through Thursday
- No work shall be allowed from 4 p.m. Friday to 5:30 a.m. Monday







Construction activates will be completed in three phases to minimize impacts; work will be performed as follows:



- Phase 1: Perform drainage work; upgrade curb ramps, curb and gutter, sidewalk and signage (along the south side and north side, but not concurrently)
- Phase 2: Adjust manholes and valves, repave and place temporary striping
- Phase 3: Install final pavement markings







#### **Posted Speed:**

Existing 30 miles per hour speed limits will be maintained during construction



#### **Dust:**

 The contractor will be required to water and sweep in order to minimize construction-related dust







#### Noise:

Some noise should be expected during allowable construction time



#### Access:

 Access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times
