PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

The purpose of this project is to improve transit ridership and reliability by implementing a dedicated bus lane. The SR 968/Flagler Street SMART Demonstration Project will be implemented on a segment within the **SR 968/Flagler Street Premium Transit Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study** and will include converting one travel lane on SR 968/Flagler Street and one travel lane on SW 1 Street to a Business Access Transit (BAT) Lane, applying appropriate pavement markings, and installing signage to inform the public of the enhanced, dedicated bus infrastructure.



ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDE:

- Restriping the curbside lane for bus only use
- Placing red pavement to designate BAT Lane
- Upgrading roadway signage and pavement markings



SCHEDULE/POST CONSTRUCTION



Construction is expected to take approximately nine months and begin in the summer of 2024.

Once construction is completed, FDOT will monitor the operation for one year and collect important performance data to measure the effectiveness of the transit and safety improvements.

Additionally, FDOT will engage in a comprehensive education campaign for the community, which will take place two months before construction commences in 2024. This campaign aims to inform and educate the community about this new service.



FUNDING

The estimated construction cost for this project is about \$5.5 million.
