



 This project will provide a crosswalk enhancing safety for all road users (motorists and pedestrians)




Updated Project Scope

- Providing a new signalized midblock crossing *
- Adding a right-turn only on northbound NW 11 Avenue *
- Repaving and restriping the road *
- Adding a right-turn only sign on southbound NW 11 Avenue
- Widening the sidewalk for pedestrian crossing and upgrading curb ramps
- Reconstructing the existing bus stop on the northeast corner of SR 25 and NW 11 Avenue
- Reconstructing driveways within the new sidewalk areas
- Improving pedestrian signage and lighting

What to Expect During Construction



Maintenance of Traffic (MOT):

- Lane closures shall occur during non-peak hours or on non-event days/weekends
- At least one travel lane in each direction will remain at all times

Non-peak hours are:

- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday through Thursday nights
- 11 p.m. to 7 a.m. Friday and Saturday nights



What to Expect During Construction



Posted Speed:

Existing 35 miles per hour speed limits will be maintained during construction



Dust:

 The contractor will be required to water and sweep in order to minimize construction-related dust



What to Expect During Construction



Noise:

Some noise should be expected during allowable construction time



Access:

Access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times
