## Golden Glades Multimodal Transportation Facility (GGMTF) Pedestrian Paths Being Relocated; Minor Traffic Shift

Begins: 9 p.m., February 18, 2021

### UPCOMING WORK

Beginning at 9 p.m. on February 18, the work zone will be expanded at the GGMTF to build the bus loop, north canopy and pedestrian bridge. Pedestrian paths throughout the facility will be temporarily relocated to accommodate the larger work zone. Motorists will also experience slight traffic shifts when entering the facility and for those wishing to use the SR 9 exit. This work is anticipated through May 31, 2021.

### WHAT TO EXPECT

There will be a temporary pedestrian path and a drop-off pick-up area from Tri-Rail leading up to SR 7. Sidewalks will be available for pedestrians walking to SR 7.

Traffic entering the facility from the SR 7 entrance will be shifted further south and the SR 9 exit will be re-rerouted through Connector Road. All other traffic routes will remain the same throughout.

***This shift will be in place beginning at 9 p.m., February 18 through May 31, 2021.***

### IMPORTANT NOTE

For your safety, please follow the posted signs to guide you to the crosswalks.

### BACKGROUND

This work is part of the overall improvements to the Golden Glades Multimodal Transportation Facility in Miami-Dade County. This project began in December 2018 and has an estimated cost of \$60 million.

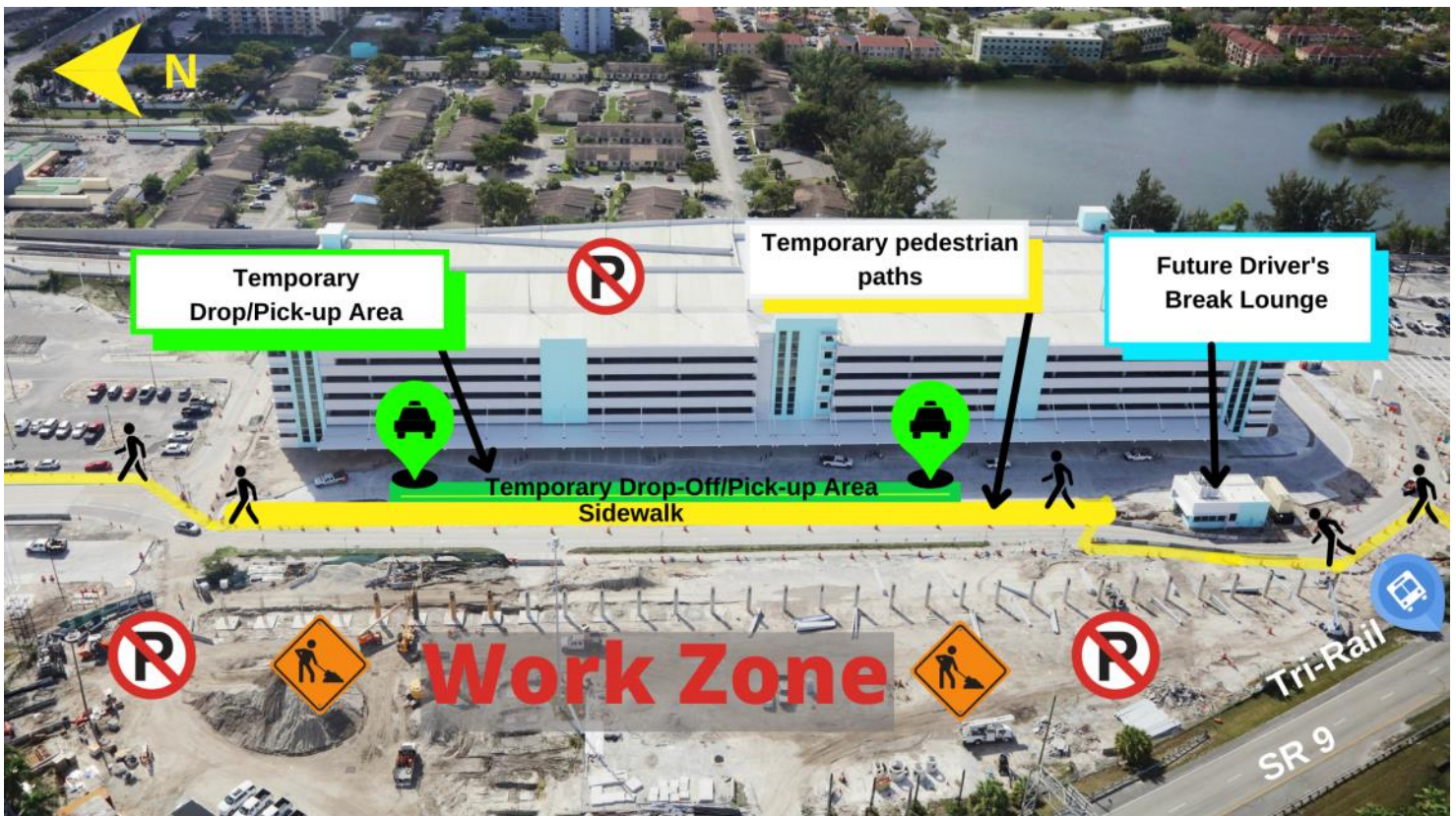
