



NEW PROJECT ALERT

Beginning the week of December 5, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway project along SR 5/US 1/South Dixie Highway. The work will last roughly one year and will cost an estimated \$6 million.

WORK TO BE PERFORMED:

- Replacing traffic signal mast arms at the intersections of Sunset Drive, SW 70 Street, Alhambra Circle, and Stanford Drive
- Constructing traffic islands at the intersections of SW 62 Avenue, SW 71 Street, and Santana Street
- Extending the left turn from northbound SR 5/US 1 to westbound Sunset Drive
- Upgrading vehicular and pedestrian signals, signage and pavement markings
- Reconstructing pedestrian sidewalks, curb ramps, and curb and gutters
- Replacing existing guardrail
- Rehabilitating the bridge over the Coral Gables Waterway (Bridge #870019)

LANE CLOSURE INFORMATION:

Travel lanes and sidewalks shall be closed only during non-peak hours on non-event days. Non-peak hours are:

- 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., weekdays and weekends
- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday nights
- 11 p.m. to 7 a.m., Friday and Saturday nights

DETOUR INFORMATION:

During this project, it will be necessary to establish detours for specific construction activities. Information will be distributed to the public prior to implementing detours.

Please follow all posted signage and use caution when traveling through the construction zone and note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
