



ONGOING/UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

FRIDAY, AUGUST 11 THROUGH SUNDAY, AUGUST 27, 2023

Drainage and Roadway Work

- Ongoing drainage work within swale areas throughout the project corridor along eastbound and/or westbound SR 994/Quail Roost Drive
- Begin construction of shoulder widening throughout the project corridor along eastbound and/or westbound SR 994/Quail Roost Drive
- Miscellaneous roadway repaving throughout the project corridor
- Relocation and/or removal of landscape material
- CSX railroad rehabilitation
 - *To be performed by CSX Transportation. See below for more information.*

DAYTIME LANE CLOSURES:

- At least one eastbound/westbound of SR 994/Quail Roost Drive will be closed (**as needed**) at various locations from Krome Avenue to SW 137 Avenue, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., Friday, August 11 through Sunday, August 27, 2023.
 - *Access to local traffic along eastbound and westbound SR 994/Quail Roost Drive will be maintained at all times.*
 - *Drivers who wish to bypass the work zone from either direction of SR 994/Quail Roost Drive can use SW 216 Street as an alternate route.*

CSX TRANSPORTATION (RAILROAD) CLOSURES:

- A **full continuous closure** of SR 994/SW 200 Street/Quail Roost Drive will be implemented from SW 147 Avenue to SW 158 Avenue **starting at 5 a.m. Friday, August 18 through 4 a.m. Tuesday, August 22.**
- During this closure, all traffic will be detoured away from the crossing and directed to follow signs to alternate local streets. Traffic will be detoured as follows:
 - *Westbound SR 994/Quail Roost Drive will be detoured through SW 147 Avenue, SW 216 Street, and SW 162 Avenue.*
 - *Eastbound SR 994/Quail Roost Drive will be detoured through SW 162 Avenue, SW 216 Street, and SW 147 Avenue.*
