Roadway, Drainage, Concrete, Signal, and Lighting Work

- Ongoing roadway reconstruction/drainage work along northside of NW 74 Street (Perimeter Road) and westside of NW 69 Avenue

- Ongoing concrete sidewalk reconstruction/curb ramp installation
- Ongoing underground utility, signalization, and lighting work along

CONTINUOUS DAYTIME/NIGHTTIME LANE CLOSURES:

- The following lanes will be continuously to perform roadway reconstruction, drainage work and to install traffic signal foundations:
 - [**SR 934/Hialeah Expressway:**](#)
 - The westbound off-ramp to NW 69 Avenue will be closed.
 - Drivers who wish to access NW 69 Avenue will be detoured through SR 934/Hialeah Expressway (West), NW 72 Street/Milam Dairy Road (North), and NW 74 Street (Perimeter Road, East).
 - Please refer to the lane closure map below.
 - [**NW 69 Avenue:**](#)
 - Access to NW 74 Street (Perimeter Road) will be closed.
 - Drivers who wish to access NW 74 Street (Perimeter Road) will be detoured through SR 934/Hialeah Expressway (East), W 8 Avenue (South), W 19 Street (West), and Okeechobee Road (North).
 - Access from NW 74 Street (Perimeter Road) will be maintained.
 - Please refer to the lane closure map below.

Please follow all posted signage and note that drivers might experience delays traveling through the area and should seek alternate routes if possible. This schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
