Beginning tomorrow, Wednesday, January 17, the following travel lanes will be closed at the intersection of NW 74 Street and NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road to perform concrete work at the NE corner of the intersection:

- **One westbound right turn lane** of NW 74 Street approaching the intersection of NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road will be **continuously closed for one day**.
 - *The lane will be closed through Wednesday, January 17 to allow for new concrete curbs to settle.*
 - *Motorists are permitted to use the inside through lane of westbound NW 74 Avenue to turn right onto northbound NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road.*
 - *Access into Burger King will be maintained.*
- **One northbound through lane** of NW 72 Avenue/Milam Dairy Road (between Hialeah Expressway and NW 74 Street) will be **closed during daytime hours only**.

Please follow all posted signage and note that drivers might experience delays traveling through the area and should seek alternate routes if possible. This schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
