
## **DAYTIME LANE CLOSURES:**

  - Drivers who wish to bypass the work zone from either direction of SR 994/Quail Roost Drive can use SW 216 Street as an alternate route.


## **NIGHTTIME LANE CLOSURES:**

  - Drivers who wish to bypass the work zone from either direction of SR 994/Quail Roost Drive can use SW 216 Street as an alternate route.


PHASE 1: SW 137 AVENUE TO SW 147 AVENUE
