**SPECIAL NOTICE REGARDING MIAMI-DADE WATER AND SEWER DEPARTMENT
EMERGENCY REPAIRS ALONG NW 74 STREET**

The Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (WASD) is resuming the critical, proactive rehabilitation to portions of the 96-inch raw water main located along NW 74 Street in the Town of Medley. Detour signage will be in place and police will be on-site directing traffic. Work during the construction period will take place 24 hours a day until completed.

ONGOING/UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

MONDAY, MARCH 11 THROUGH SUNDAY, MARCH 24, 2024

Roadway, Concrete, Signal, Lighting, and Restoration Work

- Ongoing roadway work along NW 74 Street and NW 69 Avenue
- Ongoing concrete sidewalk reconstruction/curb ramp installation
- Ongoing underground utility, signalization, and lighting work
- Ongoing restoration throughout project corridor.

DAYTIME LANE CLOSURES

- At least one eastbound and/or westbound lane of NW 74 Street will be closed (**as needed**) at various locations from NW 74 Avenue to NW 69 Avenue, between the hours of 9 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., Monday, March 11 through Sunday, March 24, 2024.
- One lane in each direction along NW 74 Street **will be maintained at all times**, Monday, March 11 through Sunday, March 24, 2024.
- Temporary lane closures may also occur along the Hialeah Expressway (**as needed**) to perform corresponding activities.

Please follow all posted signage and note that drivers might experience delays traveling through the area and should seek alternate routes if possible. This schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
