

OVERVIEW

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) began various intersection projects along SR A1A/ Collins Avenue on November 15, 2021 in Miami-Dade County.

WORK TO BE PERFORMED

At 10, 11, 14 and 74 Street

- Replacing traffic signal mast arms
- Replacing pedestrian signal poles
- Restoring pedestrian sidewalks, curb ramps, and curb and gutters
- Repaying and restriping at the intersections of 11 Street and 14 Street
