FDOT COMPASS: SAFETY

A Midblock Pedestrian Signal (MPS) is an overhead traffic device that resembles a regular traffic signal and assists with the safe crossing of cyclists and pedestrians. The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has synchronized the MPS at this crosswalk on SR 5/US 1/N Roosevelt Boulevard with the traffic signals at the nearby intersections of Kennedy Drive/Sigsbee Road and Overseas Market.

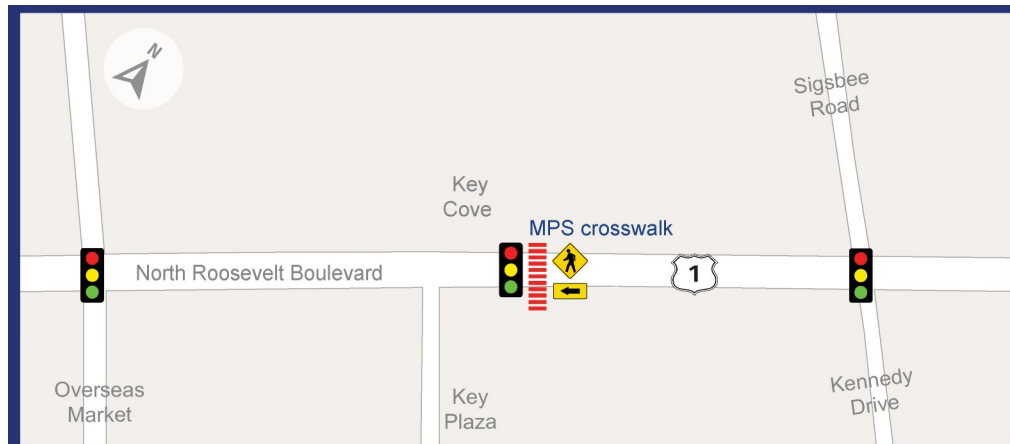
