FDOT Completes State Road (SR) 994/Quail Roost Drive Roadway Project

FDOT has successfully completed the SR 994/Quail Roost Drive roadway project from SR 997/Krome Avenue to SR 825/SW 137 Avenue. This nine-month project began in July 2023 and cost approximately \$4.1 million.

FDOT, along with its contractor, General Asphalt Company, LLC., completed this project both on schedule and on budget. This project aimed to correct numerous sight-distance issues along SR 994/Quail Roost Drive and enhanced roadway conditions to allow the nurseries in the area to continue the movement of landscape services that help maintain the beauty of South Florida.

The scope of work included: repaving and restriping the roadway; installing new drainage structures in the swale areas along Quail Roost Drive; relocating or removing landscape; upgrading signalization features at the intersection of SW 147 Avenue/Naranja Road; and upgrading vehicular signage throughout the corridor.
