FDOT COMPASS

FDOT is committed to ensuring the State's infrastructure serves residents, businesses, and visitors to meet their current and future transportation needs. Benefits of this project include:

SAFETY

- Repaving and restriping the roadway
- Upgrading and installing new guardrail
- Upgrading signage and pavement markings
- Reconfiguring right turn lanes at three locations to accommodate bicyclists

RESILIENCY

- Reconstructing sections of Overseas Highway travel lanes

LANE CLOSURE INFORMATION

Travel lane can be closed during the following hours:

- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday nights

Access to businesses and residences will be maintained. Road closure information will be posted weekly on the department's website, www.southflroads.com.

DETOUR INFORMATION

When road closures are implemented, SR 5/Overseas Highway traffic will be detoured on to **Card Sound Road**. Specific detour information will be provided before any corresponding activities are scheduled.

MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC

- To reconstruct the northbound travel lane, the southbound roadway will be temporarily widened and both northbound and southbound traffic will be shifted onto the southbound roadway.
- Once implemented, this traffic pattern will remain in place until the northbound work is complete.
- To reconstruct the southbound travel lanes, nightly southbound road closures will be implemented and traffic will be detoured on to **Card Sound Road**.



WHAT TO EXPECT

Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects of construction on the community. Temporary road closures may affect traffic during non-peak hours. All detours will be established with clear signage.
