### Northbound S.R. 826/Palmetto Expressway Ramp to Northbound I-75 Lane Closures

*February 13 through February 22*


**MIAMI, Fla.** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will implement ramp closures beginning Friday, February 13 through Sunday, February 22, along the State Road (S.R.) 826/Palmetto Expressway northbound ramp to I-75, for bridge repairs.

The lane closure schedule is as follows:

- Friday, February 13: **Overnight full closure** of northbound S.R. 826 ramp to northbound I-75 from 10 p.m. until Saturday, February 14 at 5:30 a.m. [See detour information below.](#)
- Saturday, February 14 through Saturday, February 21: **Continuous one lane closure** along the northbound S.R. 826 ramp to northbound I-75.
- Saturday, February 21: **Overnight full closure** of northbound S.R. 826 ramp to northbound I-75 from 10 p.m. until Sunday, February 22 at 5:30 a.m. [See detour information below.](#)

**Overnight full closure detour information:** Drivers going northbound will continue along S.R. 826, pass the I-75 exit, and exit on Miami Lakes Drive, turn left going west, and then turn left to re-enter S.R. 826 southbound. Continue southbound until the I-75 exit. (See detour map below).

Expect delays, especially during peak traffic hours.



This schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.
